


VOLT IN HOLT

Paulina and Dominik have been cooperating with electricity as a duo since 2020. At the end of 2021, they started creating electrical paintings. Through the technique they have developed, they can present the complexity of the universe and the mechanisms that govern it. Their abstract works are created mainly on paper, although they are not limited to this substrate, constantly expanding their means of expression. They presented their works during individual and group exhibitions.

ARTIST STATEMENT

Our artistic vision has been shaped by the fascinating and unpredictable nature of electrical discharges. This phenomenon has inspired us to delve into the intricacies and subtleties of reality, exploring its specific structure and creating an environment that encourages reflection on the complexities of our world. Our technique embodies this complexity, allowing us to present works that convey the spiritual essence of physical reality, the underlying mechanisms that govern it, and the fact that we may never be able to fully understand it.



THE BEGINNING

Our first two series of works were created as a collaboration of three people: Dominik Kuryga, Paulina Nadia Weremczuk and Adrianna Trybuchowicz-Mojska. Initially, it was a photographic experiment, during which we recorded a sliding discharge on photosensitive paper. It was supposed to be only an answer to the intriguing question of what result we would get. However, when the first fractal patterns appeared, we noticed something almost transcendent in their structure. We realized that our works can be used as a means of artistic expression.


THE CREATIVE PROCESS

To create, we use a self-developed high-voltage pulse generator and discharge device. Photosensitive paper or material coated with a photosensitive emulsion is subjected to pulse voltages with an amplitude in the order of 300 kV. By placing various items and substances on it, using different types of electrodes and pulse parameters, we obtain a very wide range of results.



COOPERATION WITH ELECTRICITY

Painting with electricity is not only a pure record of electrical discharges. These are also effects typically related to the presence of electrical discharges - plasma and their interactions with the objects we place on the surface.




UNIVERSAL DIMENSION

The uniqueness and abstract character of the works inspired us to create a naming system inspired by giving a name to newly discovered stars. It is a principle that crosses cultural references. It is aimed to leave interpretation freedom during the perception of a work. Moreover, the sequence of digits constitutes a kind of code for us, which we use to determine the parameters and settings of the equipment.

CANVAS

In 2023, we began our search for surfaces that would allow us to create in any desired format without being limited by its size. We impregnated a canvas with resin and covered it with a photosensitive emulsion. This method offers advantages beyond those of photosensitive paper, including the ability to produce unique effects. The slightly wavy surface influences the discharge formation process.



PVC SHEET

GLASS

When using a transparent surface, it helps to create a spatial perception of the work. By playing with light and shadow, it is able to build a relation-ship with the background that is impossible with an opaque surface.


